*Mechanic:* Person with high technical ability

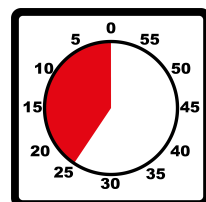
*Energy:* Energetic person, keeps the mood up and inspires others

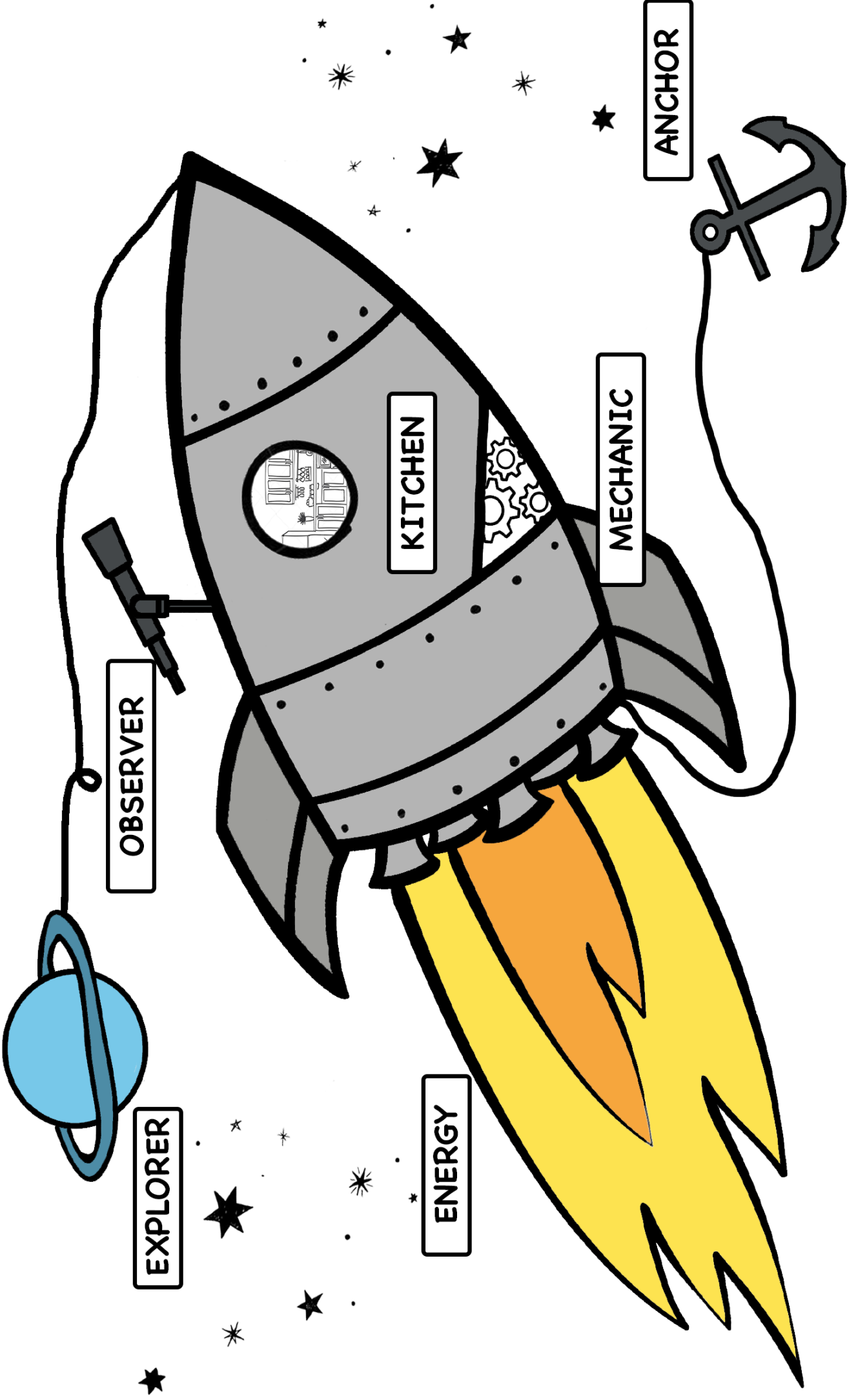
